### AIMS

With the 'Fellows' Fund', WMCFT hope to support current and previous Fellows, and craftspeople with a proven commitment to hosting travelling Fellows. The purpose of the grant is simply to enable continuation of craft practice, and to enable the recipient to continue passing on their knowledge and skills in the future. The Fund is intended to ease financial strain for craftspeople working in the historic built environment, who do not have considerable savings or other income sources to rely on.

### **GRANTS**

Grant payments are usually £500 are made at the discretion of the WMCFT Trustees overseeing the Fund.

### APPLICATIONS

Applicants must complete a short application form briefly outlining the reasons for application. We aim to keep the application simple, and to give a response swiftly. The application form is available on our website or by request from the email below. Trustees would also be pleased to discuss your application beforehand if you have any queries.

Who can apply You are eligible to apply if:

- You have completed the Fellowship programme OR
- You can demonstrate support of the Fellowship programme i.e through hosting visits and placements for Fellows.

AND you intend to continue in the heritage sector.
